- Showjumping will be judged under current Pony Club rules and for trophies the age of rider taken from 1st January 2023

- All litter/dung/hay must be picked up before you leave.
- Any complaints must be lodged with the secretary before prizegiving accompanied with £20, refundable in the event of the complaint being upheld.

- All Competitors must wear correctly secured hats that at all times conform to current Pony Club rules when mounted.
