Horses must be 4yrs or over for classes 1 & 2 and 5yrs or over classes 3, 4 & 5

Riders must be 17yrs or over

Competitors will jump a course of show jumps followed by a course of cross country style fences all within the indoor school at ISEC. There will be a rosette for the best EFRA member in each class

<u>Class 1</u> <u>Max Height 65cms.</u> Restricted to horses who have not won at Riding Club Novice level or above or won or been placed in any BE event.

<u>Class 2</u> Max Height 75cms. Restricted to horses who have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at Riding Club Intermediate show jumping level or at a BE 80 event.

<u>Class 3</u> Max Height 85cms Restricted to horses who have not been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd at Riding Club Open show jumping or BE 90 level or above

Class 4 Max Height 95cms Open

Class 5 Max Height 1.05M Open

Dress code – as for XC. Please note new standards for hats & body protectors

COMPETITION INFO AND RULES

- 1. Run under BRC & BE JAS rules
- 2. The competition will run over a course of showjumps followed by a section of natural fences within the indoor arena. The 'cross country' section will be timed and clear rounds will take precedence over anyone with jumping faults. The winner will be the closest to the optimum time over the timed section of the course.
- 3. The course will be split into 2 halves, the first will not be timed, and the second will be timed (1 time fault will be given for each commenced second under or over the optimum time allowed).
- 4. The 3rd refusal or the fall of horse elimination
- 5. 2nd fall of rider elimination
- 6. The winner will be the competitor with the lowest number of faults who is closest to the optimum time.
- 7. No watches will be permitted.
- 8. Horse and Rider combination may compete in 2 consecutive classes
- 9. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted
- 10. Horses and ponies must **not** be left unattended whilst tied to trailers / lorries

New Hat/Body Protector Rules

<u>Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC competition</u>

- i) PAS015 (1998 or 2011) and must have official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- ii) VG1 01.040 (2014-12) and must have official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- iii) ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) and must have official SEI Mark
- iv) SNELL E2001 or E2016 and must have official SNELL label and number
- v) AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) and must have official SAI global mark

HORSE

It is the riders responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may invalidate any insurance Body protectors must be BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label.

The ONLY exception to the requirement for a BETA Level 3 2009 purple label is that Exo Body Cages will continue to be accepted, provided they have a BETA Level 3 2000 purple label & the competitor must inform the event secretary
