### Class 1

Open to teams of three/four riders and horse/ponies. Maximum height in first round 55cm. Horse/pony/rider combinations not to have been placed 1st-3rd at novice level show jumping or above. (No Fillers)

## Class 2.

Open to teams of three/four riders and horse/ponies. Maximum height in first round 70cm. Horse/pony/rider combinations not to have been placed 1st-3rd more than 3 times in intermediate or open show jumping competitions.

### Class 3.

Open to teams of three/four riders and horse/ponies. Maximum height in the first round 80cm. Horse/pony/rider combinations not to have been placed 1st-3rd more than 3 times in open show jumping competitions.

# Class 4.

Open to teams of three/four riders and horse/ponies. Maximum height in the first round 95cm. Open to any horse/pony/rider combination.

# Class 5.

Open to teams of three/four riders and horse/ponies. Maximum height in first round 1.05m. Open to any horse/pony/rider combination.

Come and have fun with your team at our Winter "Snow" Jumping event! Whilst we do require competitors to be safely dressed in accordance with BRC rules, we are happy for competitors to wear team colours or fancy dress for this event.

Prizes will be awarded on the day for Best Team Outfit and Best Team Fancy Dress.







## **COMPETITION RULES**

Teams can be made up of any combination of horse/pony and senior or junior riders.

Each team can be made up of three or four members. The three best scores will count from each round. If you are eliminated you will be given a score of the highest penalties from that round + 20 so that your team will have a score.

**Each team will be required to complete two rounds of jumping.** The first round will not be timed, the second round will be higher (maximum 5-10cm) and will be timed, in the case of equal penalties, the times from the second round of the 3 scores that count, will be added together for the final positions.

Each team is required to nominate a Team Manager who is responsible for the overall organisation of the team.

**TIMES:** The times will be available on the Glenbrae Riding Club website, Club Entries website and Glenbrae Riding Club Facebook page on the Thursday before the competition (11<sup>th</sup> January 2018). Times will be between 8.30 and 2pm.

**RULES :** This competition is run in accordance with current BRC rules however the following rules also apply:

- 1. The Judge's decision is final
- 2. Riders must give due consideration to all others at the venue
- 3. The Organisers reserve the right to
  - (a) cancel any class
  - (b) divide or amalgamate any class
  - (c) alter the advertised times
  - (d) refuse any entry without giving any reason.

4. Officials must be obeyed at all times. Abuse of officials, including verbal abuse, will not be tolerated and may result in elimination of the rider.

5. All riders should be safely dressed.

6. Hats must conform to current BRC guidance and must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

7. It is strongly advised that juniors wear body protectors at all times. Adults are advised to wear one when jumping.

8. Combinations thought to be competing at the wrong level will be asked to compete H.C. or asked to move up a level.

9. Please note that the venue does not allow dogs on the premises.

10. All hay, droppings and litter must be tidied from car park before leaving.





### HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

#### 1. CONDUCT

Emergency Services must have access to all parts of the competition site at all times. Members of the public must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access.

All directional signs and markers must be strictly adhered to.

All instructions from the organiser, or officials acting on their behalf, must be strictly adhered to.

All areas designated HORSE ONLY must be kept free of spectators at all times.

Any action hazardous to Health and Safety should be reported to the organiser as soon as possible.
