General Information

Shooting

The competition will run under Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules 2020. All guns must be kept boxed and secure and in possession of responsible person over the age of 18 years who holds an Air weapon certificate at all times, except during the shooting competition when under the supervision of the shooting steward.

Competitors in classes 1-8 must have received some shooting training and be safe and competent to shoot

Loaders must be 18 or over

All competitors must wear protective glasses while shooting. Long trousers are compulsory.

Swimming

If you are a weak swimmer you can request an outside lane so you can stop for a break this incurs no penalty, only time therefore reduces your overall score.

The Intros (class 9 & 10) only swim half the pool at the shallow end. A float can be used with no penalty. There will be people in the pool to help them.

No photography/video in pool area

Running

Will be run as a time trial around the campus grounds. There will be maps of the courses displayed
