Conditions of Entry

General:

Ages of competitors will be taken from 1 January 2022 as the league will not finish until March 2022.

The competition will be run under current Pony Club Dressage Rules. Note: - Competitors 10 y/o and under can ride in any bit they feel safe in. Competitors in classes 4-6b must ride in a bit/tack allowed under pony club dressage rules.

Competitors will be allowed to enter two tests, and rosettes will be awarded, but league points will only be awarded to placings in the age group section. Please note that competitors may only receive one allocated warm up time in the indoor which will be prior to their first test. The outdoor school may be available for warm-up, weather dependent.

Per the 2020 PC Dressage rules (Rule 31 – Commanders), all tests may be commanded. However, members who are wishing to compete at Areas and Championships should be aware that commanders are not permitted at this level, and we would encourage members to learn the tests and use this opportunity to ride the test without a commander. NOTE the 2020/21 Dressage Rule Book is available, and any updates/changes to tests may be included in the subsequent competitions.

Trophies will be awarded at the end of the league to the highest placed member in classes 2b, 3b, 4b, 5b, & 6b. Points will be awarded as follows to the same horse and rider combination throughout the league. 1st - 7 points, 2nd - 6 points, 3rd - 5 points, 4th - 4 points, 5th - 3 points, 6th - 2 points. If you are not placed you will receive 1 point for competing
