Eligibility Criteria for Horses/ Ponies and Riders - see Rule Book - Pages 94 - 96.

Team / Individual Qualifier Classes (Open to BRC Area 1 Riding Club members.)

SHOW JUMPING

All competitors jump two rounds. If a team member is eliminated in the first round they are permitted to compete in the second round, however individuals eliminated in the first round are not permitted to compete in the second round. All rounds will be timed. The times for the second round are used to determine minor placings when faults cannot do this. If there is equality for first place after the second round there will be a jump off around a course which may be shortened and raised at the discretion of the judge and the official steward against the clock. For teams the best three scores in each round will count for the total score.

The Event is run under British Riding Club Rules for Area Qualifiers.

FOR AREA QUALIFIERS - All preliminary entries (Team and Individual) for dressage, riding test, show jumping and style jumping qualifiers must be made through your riding club to BRC HQ no later than **Saturday 15th June 2019**. Horse/Pony name MUST be as per passport

Equine 'Flu Vaccinations

All Team Managers must submit clear copies or pictures of equine passport pages showing name of horse/pony, all equine 'flu vaccination pages, name of rider and Club via e-mail (MAXIMUM file size of 5 Mb) to Maggie Bunnett via e-mail <u>no later than Thursday 21st June</u> to: thebunnetts@btinternet.com

Any equine 'flu vaccination records received after this date OR on the day will be charged a £5 admin fee per passport check.

There will be a designated First Aid Point at the entrance to the main indoor arena.

TEAM MANAGER / COMPETITOR NOTES

Clubs are required to provide one NON RIDING helper per team entered (and/or one helper per 4 individuals). Helper information MUST be completed online at: www.clubentries.com/area1

Volunteer information must be provided at time of final entries. Any Clubs that do not provide named non-riding helpers plus contact details in advance will have one member disqualified per missing helper. Please note that the helpers are still required even if team or individuals withdraw.

Style jumping: riders jump 1 round. All other classes - riders jump 2 rounds.

All Classes will be in drawn order. Competition will start at approximately 8.30 am on both days.

Timings – will be published on Area 1 website on Thursday 4th July (evening). Show Jumping Timings will be approximate to allow for jump offs where there are multiple double clear rounds.

It is the **responsibility of each competitor** to ensure their horse vaccination record meets BRC rules and that they are eligible for classes entered.

If invalid documents, ineligible horse or rider is **declared BEFORE** the qualifier competition, all 4 riders can still compete but only 3 valid rider scores will count. If less than 3 are valid, the team may compete if space allows, but entry will be HC.

If any horse or rider at the qualifier is later found to be ineligible, then the **team will be eliminated**, with any qualification being passed to the next eligible team.

In the unlikely event of the event having to be cancelled, a percentage of the entry fee will be retained to cover admin and arena hire costs.

Please note all Championship Invitations are issued by BRC Head Office, as all results require to be verified.

<u>Eligibility Criteria for Horses/ Ponies</u>: See pages 94-99 in the BRC Rule Book. Check Area 1 website - reference page for any rule changes or amendments from BRC.

ON THE DAY

FULLY completed Declaration Sheets: Please ensure these sheets are fully completed including all membership and passport numbers. Declaration forms must be submitted before competing.

Riding Club Membership Cards must be shown to the secretary on the day.

Horse/Pony Passports must be shown to the secretary on the day.

BRC Hat tagging rules apply. Hat tagging will be available on the day, but it is advisable to check www.brcarea1.co.uk/reference for compliance in advance.

A start fee of £1 per test (for all dressage classes) will be payable on the day to cover payment of judges. A First Aid Fee of £3 per rider will be payable <u>in advance</u> for Show and Style Jumping classes on the Sunday to help cover the cost of Paramedic Cover.

Objections

Protests or complaints may be lodged in writing and handed to the Event Secretary. The protest must be accompanied by a deposit of £20.00. They must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident that gave rise to that protest, or 30 minutes after the results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it was decided there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.
