Equine 'Flu Vaccinations

All Team Managers must submit clear copies or pictures of equine passport pages showing name of horse/pony, all equine 'flu vaccination pages, name of rider and Club via e-mail (MAXIMUM file size of 5 Mb) to Maggie Bunnett via e-mail <u>no later than Saturday 22nd February</u> to: thebunnetts@btinternet.com

Any equine 'flu vaccination records received after this date will **<u>NOT</u>** be checked in advance and may incur a £5 late admin fee.

Personal Information: You agree that we may publish your Personal Information as part of the results of events and may pass such information to the governing body or any affiliated organisation for the purpose of qualification, insurance or for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compared to other events. Results may include (but not be limited to) name, club, times and age category.

PHOTOGRAPHS: Official photographs and video will be taken at this event and may be published on websites, social media or in other publications. If you do not want your image(s) to be used, please inform the event secretary a minimum of two weeks in advance of the event.

TEAM MANAGER / COMPETITOR NOTES

All Classes will be in drawn order. Competition will start at approximately 9 am.

Timings – will be published on Area 1 website on Thursday 12th March (evening).

It is the **responsibility of each competitor** to ensure their horse vaccination record meets BRC rules and that they are eligible for classes entered.

If invalid documents, ineligible horse or rider is **declared BEFORE** the qualifier competition, all 4 riders can still compete but only 3 valid rider scores will count. If less than 3 are valid, the team may compete if space allows, but entry will be HC.

If any horse or rider at the qualifier is later found to be ineligible, then the **team will be eliminated**, with any qualification being passed to the next eligible team.

In the unlikely event of the event having to be cancelled, a percentage of the entry fee will be retained to cover admin and arena hire costs.

Withdrawals - refunds will only be made in exceptional circumstances.

Please note that all Championship Invitations are issued by BRC Head Office. HQ staff verify all results prior to invitations being sent out via-email to Club Team Managers.

<u>Eligibility Criteria for Horses/ Ponies</u>: Check pages 94-98 in the BRC Rule Book. Check BRC website for any rule changes or amendments.

ON THE DAY (Secretaries Office will be open from 8.30 am.)

FULLY completed Declaration Sheets: Please ensure these sheets are fully completed including all membership and passport numbers. Declaration forms must be submitted by the Club's Team Manager (or first Club member on site) before any of the Club's members compete.

Hats and Body Protectors - it is the rider's responsibility to ensure that they comply with current BRC rules. A hat to the correct standard must be worn at all times by anyone, whether a competitor or not, riding anywhere at this event.

Hat tagging will be available on the day, but it is advisable to check the BRC website for compliance in advance. The current hat tag colour is AQUA. Please allow sufficient time to have hat tagged, there may be a queue.

Riding Club Membership Cards & Horse/Pony Passports must be shown to the secretary on the day. These should be presented in the Secretaries Office and once checked you will be able to collect your number. If you are collecting numbers for others from your Club please ensure that you have all Cards and Passports with you. You must also pay the £1 per Test at the same time.

<u>Numbers</u> will be issued <u>only</u> after Equine Passports and BRC membership cards have been checked and £1 start fee per test has been paid by the competitor.

Please NOTE back numbers are to be worn by all competitors. Bridle numbers can be worn but only in addition to not instead of back numbers. Please ensure that the correct number is worn.

<u>OBJECTIONS</u>: Protests or complaints may be lodged in writing and handed to the Event Secretary. The protest must be accompanied by a deposit of £20.00. They must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident that gave rise to that protest, or 30 minutes after the results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it was decided there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.
