Club Helpers

Volunteer information must be provided at time of final entries. Any Clubs that do not provide named non-riding helpers plus contact details in advance will have one member disqualified per missing helper. Please note that the helpers are still required even if team or individuals withdraw.

<u>Area 1 Novice Winter Dressage Qualifier - ENTRY RULES</u>

The Event is run under British Riding Club Rules for Area Qualifiers.

FOR AREA QUALIFIERS - All preliminary entries (Team and Individual) must be made through your riding club to BRC HQ no later than <u>Saturday 2nd November 2019</u>. Horse/Pony name MUST be as per passport. Preliminary Entry fee: £29 per Team / £9.50 per individual. ALL team members are automatically entered into the individual competition.

Any equine 'flu vaccination records received after this date will **NOT** be checked in advance.

TEAM MANAGER / COMPETITOR NOTES

All Classes will be in drawn order. Competition will start at approximately 9 am.

Timings – will be published on Area 1 website on Thursday 21st November (evening).

It is the **responsibility of each competitor** to ensure their horse vaccination record meets BRC rules and that they are eligible for classes entered.

If invalid documents, ineligible horse or rider is **declared BEFORE** the qualifier competition, all 4 riders can still compete but only 3 valid rider scores will count. If less than 3 are valid, the team may compete if space allows, but entry will be HC.

If any horse or rider at the qualifier is later found to be ineligible, then the **team will be eliminated**, with any qualification being passed to the next eligible team.

In the unlikely event of the event having to be cancelled, a percentage of the entry fee will be retained to cover admin and arena hire costs.

Please note all Championship Invitations are issued by BRC Head Office, as all results require to be verified.

<u>Eligibility Criteria for Horses/ Ponies</u>: See pages 94-99 in the BRC Rule Book. Check Area 1 website - reference page for any rule changes or amendments from BRC.

ON THE DAY

<u>FULLY completed Declaration Sheets:</u> Please ensure these sheets are fully completed including all membership and passport numbers. Declaration forms must be submitted by the Team Manager before competing.

BRC Hat tagging rules apply. Hat tagging will be available on the day, but it is advisable to check www.brcarea1.co.uk/reference for compliance in advance. The current hat tag colour is AQUA. Please allow sufficient time to have hat tagged, there may be a queue.

Riding Club Membership Cards & Horse/Pony Passports must be shown to the secretary on the day. These should be presented in the Secretaries Office and once checked you will be able to collect your number. If you are collecting numbers for others or your team please ensure that you have all Cards and Passports with you. You must also pay the £1 per Test at the same time.

Numbers: These will only be issued once Cards and Passports have been checked.

Please NOTE back numbers are to be worn by all competitors. Bridle numbers can be worn but only in addition to not instead of back numbers. Please ensure that the correct number is worn.

OBJECTIONS

Protests or complaints may be lodged in writing and handed to the Event Secretary. The protest must be accompanied by a deposit of £20.00. They must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident that gave rise to that protest, or 30 minutes after the results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it was decided there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.
