7 & 8	BEANIE BOYS & GIRLS under 8	Bean bag throw 3m	500 metres	2 Minutes (can use a float)

#### **Shooting -**

Competitors in classes 1-6 must have received some shooting training prior to the competition, and be safe and competent to shoot.

All competitors must wear protective glasses while shooting. Long trousers are compulsory.

All guns must always be kept boxed and secure and in the possession of a responsible person over the age of 18 years except during the shooting competition when under the supervision of the shooting steward.

#### **Running –**

The running will be done in mixed sex heats on the astro pitch at the back of the school. No Spikes are allowed.

#### **Swimming –**

The swimming phase is to swim as far as you can in the allowed time. If you are a weak swimmer you can request an outside lane so you can stop for a break, there is no penalty for this.

The Beanies (class 7 & 8) can use a float for the swimming and will not be penalised. They will swim at the shallow end with Junior competitors in the pool to help if needed.
