### Pick a Fence and Show Jumping

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**Horse passports must be brought. There will be random inspections. Vaccinations must be current, with annual boosters within date. If you have any questions, please call the organisers.**

All competitors MUST wear a BACK PROTECTOR AND HARD HAT, no Fixed Peak, conforming to PC standard and hats MUST BE TAGGED. **If any Rider is wearing a Bodycage or an Air Jacket, this must be worn over a back protector.**

**Non Pony Club competitors must ensure their tack and clothing complies with PC standards, hats must be tagged, and they must have their own appropriate Public Liability Insurance cover for £10m. This must be submitted by email to [lbaynejardine@gmail.com](mailto:lbaynejardine@gmail.com) immediately after you have entered. Failure to do so will result in your entry being withdrawn.**

Long hair must be secured in such a way to ensure the rider's number is clearly visible at all times.

No earrings / jewellery may be worn while competing.

Horses/Ponies must be 4yrs or over.

Horses/ponies must not be left unsupervised whilst tied to a trailer/lorry.

Electronic devices (ie headphones, mobile phones etc enabling another person to communicate with the rider) are not allowed whilst the rider is competing). No recording device is permitted – ie head / bridle cameras etc.

#### **Refund Policy**

Please note that the event entry fee and associated costs are non-refundable, including in circumstances where the competitor is unable to attend due to illness or injury or a scheduling conflict, unless:

- 1) ELPC cancels or materially delays or alters the event,
- 2) ELPC makes a significant change to the location of the event or the date of the event so that you are no longer able to attend.

In circumstances (1) or (2) above, ELPC may issue a refund of the event fee at the ELPC's sole discretion acting reasonably. **Clubentries booking fee will not be refunded.**

**RULES & SCORING**

THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL

Competitors should complete as many numbered jumps as possible with the object of obtaining the highest number of marks.

Each jump is divided into 3 options

<b>Orange</b>	<b>15 points</b>
<b>Pink</b>	<b>10 points</b>
<b>Yellow</b>	<b>5 points</b>

**Classes 1 and 2 are not allowed to jump the Orange option - jumping an Orange option will result in elimination.**

For all classes a **maximum of 3 attempts** may be made at each numbered jump, but not at the same colour, (except Yellow) - see below.

The Jumping options are as follows:

**1<sup>st</sup> attempt at Orange:**

If Orange is cleared, go to the next numbered jump.

If Orange is refused, Pink or Yellow may be attempted.

If Pink is refused, Yellow may be tried.

If Yellow is chosen after Orange and refused, a second attempt at Yellow may be made.

**1<sup>st</sup> attempt at Pink:**

If Pink is cleared, go to the next numbered jump.

If Pink is refused, only two attempts may be made at Yellow.

**1<sup>st</sup> attempt at Yellow:**

If Yellow is cleared, go to the next numbered jump.

If Yellow is refused, two more attempts may be made at Yellow.

**Only three attempts can be made at any numbered jump.**

**A Competitor attempting either Orange or Pink for a second time will be eliminated.**

No numbered jump is compulsory – a competitor who does not wish to attempt a numbered jump and proceeds to the next jump will not be eliminated, but will gain no marks for that numbered jump.

A competitor who knocks down an unfixed obstacle, breaks an obstacle or falls must proceed to the next obstacle, gaining no marks.

There will be an optimum time for each class – these times will be displayed at the secretary's tent. In the event of equal points, the rider closest to the optimum time will be judged the winner.

Competitors must approach the jumps with the red flags on the right and white flags on the left.
