ENTRIES:

Online Entries only — if you are unable to enter on Clubentries then please pm or email the contact on the schedule for BACS details.

Only one helper per horse, no spectators permitted. Name, Address and Phone Number of your helper must be provided on ClubEntries at time of entry. These will be kept for 21 days for Track and Trace purposes. Should your helper change after entries have been submitted then updated details must be sent to the event organiser Joyce Grigor (gteam22@me.com) and club Covid Officer Lyndsay Allan (lallan@britishhorseracing.com) no later than 6pm the night before the event:

Riders if wanting to do more than 1 test may only enter 2 consecutive classes.

DURING THE EVENT

<u>Please do not</u> arrive earlier than 45 minutes before your first test time as Lorries/trailers will be parked 3m apart by a parking official as space is at a premium at Dryden. Tying up outside lorries/trailers is not permitted. Any cars must be parked in the small layby immediately on the left when leaving the A7 at Dryden and not in the main or top yard.

Please maintain social distancing (2 metres) at all times. EFRA strongly recommends the use of face coverings, with the exception of when mounted

Numbers will not be issued. If you have a number bib you will be asked to print/write out your own number. Bridle or saddle cloth numbers may also be worn

A Rider competing in two classes on same horse will ride their test and be given a short breather (1 test time) inbetween to stand outside the outdoor school, during which another competitor will complete their test.

If you require a commander please provide your own.

Maximum of 4 horses allowed in warm up arena at any one time. Please do not enter without the permission of the warmup Steward.

Riders must leave the premises immediately after they have competed — no waiting or stopping to chat please.

If competing on more than 1 horse, once your first horse is finished you must stay in your vehicle until 45 mins before your second horse's test.

There will be no secretary's office and no scoreboard. The green cabin and toilet facilities will not be in use. Scores and results will be available online by midnight on day of competition. Anyone wishing to have their score sheet sent to them please bring a SAE and leave in the box/bin provided.

Social Distancing (2 metres) must be adhered to by all attendees at all times. Please adhere to instructions given by the Organiser(s), Committee Members and the Covid Officer.

Points will be awarded and the horse/rider combinations with most points will be presented with their prizes at the end of the league.

There must be two or more competitors in a class for points to be awarded. Winners of previous winter leagues may compete at same level but points will not be counted for the current league with exception of Elementary & Medium.
