Dressage - Classes start 9am. Pre-entry only

Class 1: Intro A (2008)

Class 2: Prelim 12 (2005 - revised 2016)

Class 3: Prelim 14 (2006 - revised 2016)

Class 4: Novice 27 (2007)

Show Jumping – Classes start from 9.30am. If jumping, at least 1 SJ class must be pre-entered by each rider but additional classes can be entered on the day (cash only on the day)

Class 5: 50cm Show Jumping

Class 6: 60cm Show Jumping

Class 7: 70cm Show Jumping

Class 8: 80cm Show Jumping

Class 9: 90cm Show Jumping

Combined Training – if you have entered a dressage test and a SJ class, you will be automatically entered (free of charge) for classes 10-14 below

Class 10: Combined Training 1

Class 11: Combined Training 2

Class 12: Combined Training 3

Class 13: Combined Training 4

Additional Info:-

- Entries through Clubentries only no entries will be accepted by text, Facebook, phone or post
- Dressage classes:- £18 for non-members; £15 for GRC members
- SJ classes:- £15 per class for non-members; £12 for GRC members
- First aid fee of £2 per rider
- Rosettes for 1st to 6th place in each class; Prizes up for grabs too!
- Catering, toilets & first aid on site

Rules and Regulations

- Riders are responsible for removing horse droppings from around trailer/horsebox in car park area
- · Blue Ridge arena rules must be adhered to
- No dogs are allowed at Blue Ridge Equestrian Centre
- Please dispose of all litter in bins or take home
- No cheques will be accepted on day of show cash entries only
- No refunds will be given, unless the Show requires to be cancelled by the organisers due to unforeseen circumstances and no alternative date is given
- If an alternative date is arranged and a competitor does not wish to or cannot attend on the new date, then refunds will be given within two weeks of the announcement
- If the organisers feel that the handler has insufficient control over the animal, the handler will be asked to remove the animal from the showground
- All animals must be sound
- If, in the opinion of the organiser, a horse requires veterinary attention, this will be sought with or without the consent of the owner/rider
- · The organisers reserve the right to instruct any competitor to leave the showground
- All persons whilst mounted must wear a properly fitted and secured hard hat which conforms to the current standard, and they must be dressed in a correct and proper manner
- · The judge's decision is final
- Objections to be lodged with a £20 deposit which will be returned if the appeal is successful
- CONDUCT: If the conduct of any exhibitor is such as shall, in the opinion of the organiser, be injurious to the character or interest of the show, or shall an exhibitor cause cruelty or unnecessary suffering or neglect of any animal, then the organiser may refuse their entry
- Glenbrae Riding Club or anyone acting on their behalf will not be held responsible for any damage, injury to person, vehicle or horse howsoever caused
- It is recommended that competitors have Third Party Insurance
