Pre-entries close on Wednesday the 1st June 2022. Entries will be accepted on the day at £2 extra per class. Entry fee is £5 per class unless otherwise stated. A medical charge of £2 per rider will be charged (which covers all classes). A prize will be awarded to the best tack and turnout horse or pony in classes 1-5 and 9-11.

Rosettes for 1st to 6th place in all classes. Prize money from 1st to 3rd place in each class.

First and second place from classes 1-5 will go forward to light horse championship to be held in the main ring after class 5. First and second place from classes 9-11 will go forward to the working hunter championship held in ring 2 after class 11. The champions from each championship will then be entered into the supreme of show held at 3pm in the main ring.

Main ring

Judging to commence at 9am sharp

Judge: Mrs Aileen Palmer

Class 1 Lead Rein Pony not exceeding 12.2h and rider to be 8 years and under. Lead rein to be attached to nose band.

All children will receive a rosette and first to sixth place will receive prizes.

Class 2 Best Child's Pony. Pony not to exceed 14.2h. This will be judged on the suitability of the rider and pony combination.

Prize money: 1st Prize £8, 2nd Prize £6, 3rd Prize £5.

Loryn young memorial trophy awarded to winner of class 2.

Riders in class 2 are exempt from class 1

Class 3 In hand Mixed Height Open for registered and non-registered horses and ponies. Handlers of stallions must be 14 years and over before the 1st of January 2022. Open to horses and ponies (class will be split into horse and pony sections if entries are sufficient).

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd Prize £6.

Class 4 Riding Club Horse. Horses to be 4 years old and over and to exceed 14.2h.

Competitors in class 4 are exempt from class 5

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd prize £6.

Class 5 Ridden Hunter Horse. Horse to be 4 years and over and exceeding 15h.

Winner will receive George Craig Perpetual Trophy

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd Prize £6.

Light horse championship to be held in main ring after class 5

Class 6 Ridden Clydesdale. This class is open to adults and children.

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd Prize £6

Winner of class 5 will be awarded the Henry cup.

Class 7 Fancy Dress mounted or unmounted. Horse or pony. To be judged on the most imaginative costume.

Entry fee: £2

Prize money: 1st Prize: £4, 2nd Prize £3, 3rd Prize £2.

THE SUPREME OF SHOW TROPHY, Cunningham of Craigends, will take place after class 7 in main ring at 3pm.

Class 8 Mounted Games Sack Race, Bendy Poles Race & Egg and Spoon Race. (competitors may be lead)

Entry fee: £2 each or 3 for £5 (Same price on the day)

First place: 1st Prize £4, 2nd Prize £3, 3rd Prize £2.

Ring 2 – Working Hunter Classes

Working Hunter Judge: Mrs Jessie Singleton

Starts at 9.30am Prompt.

Working hunter classes will be split into horse and pony sections.

Class 10 & 11 marking: Jumping 50%, Style & manners whilst jumping 20%, manners 10%, conformation/type/ freedom of action 20%.

Class 9 Wobbly Workers. This is an introductory working hunter class. Rider may be lead. A small show will be required by instruction of the judge, no canter included. Height of jumps: cross poles, approximately 50cm

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd Prize £6.

Class 10 Novice Working Hunter Horse/Pony

Height of jumps approximately 65cm. Open to horses and ponies. Rider and horse combination not to have won more than 3 working hunter competitions. Ponies not to exceed 153cm.

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd Prize £6.

Class 11 Open Working Hunter Horse/Pony

Height of jumps approximately 80cm. Open to horses and ponies. Ponies not to exceed 153cm.

Horse/pony and rider combination can only enter class 10 or 11

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd Prize £6.

The Highest placed pony in class 11 with be awarded the Wellees Trophy (Kindly donated by the family of Archie and Margaret Stewart)

First and second place from all workers classes will be invited forward to the working hunter championship held in ring 2 after class 11. Overall workers champion will be asked to take part in the supreme of show parade held in the main ring at 3pm.

Showjumping to commence in ring 2 after working hunter

Class 12 Wobbly / Lead Rein showjumping for novice or nervous horse and pony combinations. Max height of fences 45cm.

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd Prize £6.

Class 13. Novice jumping max height of fences 55cm. (split into horse and pony sections). Any combination competing in classes 12 & 13 cannot compete in class 14.

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd Prize £6.

Class 14. Open jumping max height of fences 65cm. (split into horse and pony sections).

Prize money: 1st Prize £10, 2nd Prize £8, 3rd Prize £6.

Best 1 or 2 year old Filly/Gelding/Colt

Class 17

Brood Mare (with foal at foot or in foal)

All rider must wear correctly fitted hats that comply with current standards. They must be worn and fastened whilst mounted.

No cantering or galloping is permitted anywhere on the show field except in the ring and collecting ring,

Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times. Please clean up after your dog.

Please pick up all your litter and place in the bins provided.

Back numbers must be worn at all times.

In the event of the show being cancelled, no money will be refunded.

All ponies/horses attending the show must have a valid passport which she be brought to the show in order to comply with government regulations.

Due to new GDPR legislation, we confirm that any personal information used in the legitimate interest of Houston Show, will be disposed of safely immediately after the event.
