2	Restricted Prelim	Prelim 2 (2016) (This is the same test as new BD Prelim 1)	Horse & Rider combination not to have won more than 3 x 1st place at Prelim Level and above.
3	Open Prelim	Prelim 12 (2005) (This is the same test as new BD Prelim 2)	No restrictions but rule 14 applies.
4	Restricted Novice	Novice 28 (2008) (This is the same test as new BD Novice 1)	Horse and Rider combination not to have been placed more than 3 x 1st at Novice Level and above.
5	Open Novice	Novice 23 (2012) (This is the same test as new BD Novice 4)	No restrictions but rule 14 applies. (Long arena test 20x60)
6	Open Elementary	Elementary 43 (2006)	No restrictions but rule 14 applies (Long arena test 20×60)
7	Open Medium	Medium 61 (2002)	No restrictions but rule 14 applies (Long arena test 20x60)

## Lothian's Riding Club Rules for Dressage Shows 2024

## Please read these rules carefully

- 1. Competition shall be run generally under the rules for British Riding Clubs competitions a link to the current year Rule Book can be found on Lothians Riding Club Website.
- 2. Lothians Riding Club, the organising committee, the owners of the show ground or any agent acting on their behalf cannot be held responsible or accept any liability for loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, owners, grooms, ground spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 3. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.
- **4.** All Rider's whether competing or not must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap property adjusted and fastened.
  - 1. PAS015: 2011 and musts have official BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC mark
  - 2. VG1 01.040: 2014-12 and must have official BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC mark.
  - 3. ASTM F1163: (2004a or 04a onwards) and must have official SEI mark.
  - 4. SNELL E2016 and must have official SNELL label and number.
  - 5. AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) and must have official SAI global mark.

## PAS 015: 1998 and SNELL E2001 are no longer accepted

- **5**. Body Protectors are not mandatory, however if you wish to wear one, body protectors must be BETA Level 3 displaying a Blue 2018 label.
- 6. Riders must wear correct footwear and be smartly dressed and if possible, wear a smart jacket.
- 7. Riders who fall off during the competition must be deemed fit to continue riding and if they wish to do so they do it entirely at their own risk.
- 8. All riders must be 18 years and over. Be a member of a Riding Club (not necessarily LRC) or hold your own 3<sup>rd</sup> Party insurance cover. Insurance Policy details must be provided from on website entry form. 18-year-olds must provide proof of age if required.
- **9**. All horses to be 4 years and over.
- 10. Horses are only permitted to compete in a maximum of 3 Dressage classes in any one day.

#### **Additional Rules**

- 11. Lothian's Riding Club members will receive league table points. A 2-layer points system based on position in class and dressage score. Dressage Points will only be awarded for the first two classes' members enter. To qualify for Points your Membership must be fully paid up in advance of any show, those who rejoin or join at a show are not able to qualify for the points at that show.
- **12**. Entry for all classes must be made in advance no field entries available. Entry fees (less admin charge) only refunded if the show is cancelled, or the classes are full. Lothians Riding Club reserves the right to cancel a show if insufficient pre-entries are received.
- **13**. Lothian's Riding Club reserves the right to refuse entries. Classes will not be held up to wait for competitors arriving late or who are not ready to compete at the correct time.
- **14**. In view of fairness **please do not enter classes competitively that you are not eligible for**, HC entries are acceptable. HC Entries do not qualify for members points.
- 15. In order of fairness and transparency Competitors, Family Members or Associates <u>must</u> not approach the Judge prior to the commencement of the class under any circumstances. Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification from that class and any other classes that the Judge is judging on the day. Once the class has finished, the Judge may be approached.
- **16.** The Judge's decision is final. Any complaints to be made in writing to the secretary and accompanied by £20. The complaint must be made within one hour of the incidence.
- 17. BHS Riding Club Rules 2024 apply to the show.
- 18. Please take your rubbish home with you and leave the venue tidy.
- **19**. Please check the website <u>www.lothiansridingclub.co.uk</u> for updates, particularly for any decisions made due to bad weather including venue changes. Directions to the venue can be found on the Club Website.
