Scottish Tetrathlon 2021/22 Postal Shoot

Four competitions to be shot over 16 weeks (Nov to Feb)

CLASSES 1 -3 Original Postal Shoot

- 12 Pony Club targets. **10 Shots on each.**
- Competitors are divided up into divisions according to the distance they shoot at and their previous or estimated scores.
- There are gold and silver medals for the winner and runner-up in each division and each age group.

CLASS 4 The Mitchell 'Family' Team Trophy

- Scores will be taken from original postal shoot targets submitted each month.
- Team is made up of 3-4 family members (must be immediate family e.g. Parents, Siblings, Aunties, Uncles, Grandparents and 1st Cousins).
- After 3 targets have been submitted each month from each team member, top 3 scores count for overall team score.
- Each team must include at least 1 PC member.
- Winning team receives trophy and medals.

CLASSES 5 and 6 Michael & Jeanie Jones Trophy competitions

- 12 ISSF/NRSA 10m Air Pistol targets. **5 shots on each.**
- PC members compete for the Jeanie Jones Trophy with 3 classes based on age and distance i.e. 7M-1H, 7M-2H or 10M. Medals for Runner-Up.
- Non-members compete for the Michael Jones Trophy. Medals for Runner-Up.

CLASS 7 The Paula Gray Trophy

- A team competition named after the founder of the postal shoot.
- Teams are three members of the same Pony Club
- Each team must have a boy of any age.
- Each team to comprise of: -
 - 1 Senior (Over 15 yrs as at 1st Jan 2022) shooting 10 metres with one hand
 - 1 Junior (14 yrs & under as at 1st Jan 2022) shooting 7 metres one hand
 - 1 Minimus (11 yrs & under as at 1st Jan 2022) shooting 7 m. with 2 hands
- More than one team per Club may be entered.
- Trophy and medals given to the winning team.

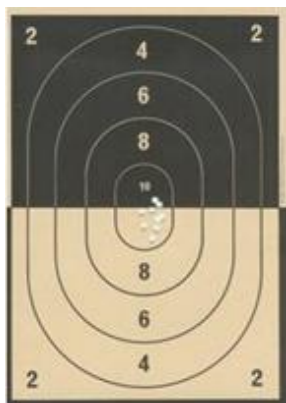
(Original) Postal Shoot The main Postal Shoot consists of 12 Pony Club targets to be shot over 16 weeks (November - February). The idea is to shoot and return three targets each month. **Ten** rounds are shot on each target. Competitors are divided up into divisions according to the range they shoot at and their previous or estimated scores.



Adults and Open competitors (15 –21 years old on 1st Jan 2022) shoot 1 handed at 10m. Junior competitors (12 –14 years old on 1st Jan 2022) shoot 1 handed at 7m. Minimus competitors (8 –11 years old on 1st Jan 2022) shoot 2 handed at 7m.

There are gold and silver medals for the winner and runner-up in each division and each age group. **Entries by 31st October 2021.**

Mitchell 'Family' Team



Trophy The Mitchell 'Family' Team Competition involves a team of a minimum of

3 family members shooting. Scores will be taken from original postal shoot targets submitted each month, so all team members must be entered in the original postal shoot competition.

Team is made up of a minimum of 3 (maximum of 4) family members, must be immediate family e.g. Parents, Aunties, Uncles, Grandparents and 1st Cousins.

Of the 3 targets submitted each month (from each team member) top 3 scores count for overall team score.

Each team must include at least 1 PC member.

Entries by 31st October 2021.

Paula Gray Team Trophy The Paula Gray competition is a team event for Pony Club members shot on Pony Club Targets with scores taken from the Original Postal Shoot.



Teams are three members of the same Pony Club.

Each team must have a boy of any age and must comprise of:

- 1 Senior (Over 15 years as at 1st January 2022) shooting 10 metres with one hand
- 1 Junior (14 years and under as at 1st January 2022) shooting 7 metres with one hand
- 1 Minimus (11 years and under as at 1st January 2022) shooting at 7 m. 2 hands

More than one team per Club may be entered. All team members must return all 12 targets by last posting date. Entry Fee £7.50 per team to be sent with entry form below by **31st October 2021** – to give you a chance to see who is shooting well.

A Challenge - Michael and Jeanie Jones Trophy Competitions



The Michael and Jeanie Jones Trophy competitions are open competitions shooting at ISSF/NRSA 10m Air Pistol targets – like those used in Modern Pentathlon. **Five** rounds are shot on each of 12 Targets – making a total of 60. Three targets are to be shot and returned each month

There are separate competitions for Members (competing for the Jeanie Jones Trophy) and for Non-members (competing for the Michael Jones Trophy). There are classes in the Jeanie Jones competition for those who are over 15 and shooting at 10m, those

14 and under who shoot at 7m with one hand, and those who shoot at 7M with two hands. **Entries by 31st October 2021.**
