

Conditions of Entry

General:

- All riders must ensure they are wearing a hard hat, fastened, at all times when mounted and this must be at least PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 standard.
- All riders must wear the correct footwear and appropriate clothing for riding.
- Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- All tack worn must be in a safe, serviceable condition.
- All horses and ponies must be 4yrs or older, be in good condition and be fit enough for the level of activity being undertaken.
- Please remove rubbish and horse droppings from around your trailer/lorry and take it home with you. Please leave the lorry parking area tidy.
- The decision of the ride organisers is final.
- Always follow the instructions of marshals and officials.
- All horses must be up to date with annual equine influenza vaccinations and must be 6 days clear from their most recent booster vaccination. Further vaccination guidance can be found using the BRC Flu Vac Checker, downloadable here.
- Horses should not be left unattended when tied to horseboxes, in the parking area or on the ride.
- It is a legal requirement to have your horses' passport when travelling to events.

Cancellations:

- No refunds after the closing date.
- If the event is cancelled by STRC, the entry fee will be refunded less £2 administration cost.

Covid-19:

- Bookings will only be accepted with a fully completed online booking form. For the purposes of 'Test and Trace', this form will be kept by the event organiser for 21 days.
- All bookings must be paid for in advance in accordance with the schedule. There will be no exchange of money on the day. Bookings will not be accepted on the day.
- Anyone feeling unwell with Covid-19 type symptoms must not attend. Please contact the organiser for a refund.
- Anyone displaying Covid-19 symptoms, however mild, should stay at home. Anyone who has been in contact
 with someone that is showing symptoms should stay at home. Anyone considered vulnerable should stay at
 home. Please inform the organiser if you need to withdraw.
- Soft face masks that cover the mouth and nose are permitted but no face shields may be worn for mounted
 activities.
- Each rider will be allocated a number when the times are issued. You may collect this number from the secretary on the day or print your own if you prefer. This needs to be on the rider in case of an accident. You can also put an identification number on your horse if you wish (this is not compulsory) which could take the form of a bridle number, number on your numnah or an ID tag.
- Sanitiser will be provided at appropriate locations and all attending should make use of it.
- There will be no passport or vaccination checking on the day. The horse's passport and a current valid annual vaccination certificate have to be available for electronic spot checks prior to the event. Please note: all passports must still travel with a horse as a legal requirement.
- Please park at least 5m apart in the designated parking area.
- Please maintain social distancing from others and when queuing for secretary/entry to the arena.
- When riding, please keep 2m apart at all times.
- All attendees must keep a 2m distance at all times whilst on site.
- There will be first aid cover. The first aider will have PPE in case they have to break social distancing guidelines.
- No sharing of equipment between riders.
- Please leave the site as soon as you can.
- Anyone not complying with the event Covid-19 Health and Safety protocol will be asked to leave the site. There are no exceptions to this rule.
- Please comply with all signage on site.

Disclaimer of Responsibility:

I consider myself to be responsible and capable of taking part and do not hold the STRC, the marshals or the venue responsible for any injury, damage or loss incurred as a result of the event. I also undertake to make good any loss or damage caused by my animals, vehicles, or myself to facilities or the environment whilst riding.
